NEWS FROM ST. TIMOTHY'S PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL...

Summer is here – sun-drenched days and starlit nights; sights, sounds of birds, butterflies and scents of flowers abound; God's beauty surrounds us; God is with us because *"God is good, all the time; and, all the time, God is good"*!

As we move from routine to relaxation, summer is the perfect time to deepen our faith and spiritual growth. Nature, at its peak, readily calls us to give thanks to God. Let us give praise and honour Him as we travel on the road, contemplate God's love for us as we relax on the beach, and serve Him as we host and gather at family or friends' BBQ's. Spend time in the stillness and quiet of the day listening to His Voice!

From PASC to PPC...

In January of this year, your **Pastoral Advisory Strategic Council (PASC)** transitioned to become your **Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)**. The reason for this transformation is directly related to the change in roles and responsibilities of the Council. And, the change is to accommodate the creation of the appropriate structures for St. Timothy in order to fulfill our call and mission as a Catholic Parish which is to *"Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations"* - Matthew 28: 19. The way each parish lives this out is determined by many things including the needs of the parish, the gifts, talents and will of its parishioners and the resources by which the parish can respond to and address those needs.

PPC and the Finance Committee will work closely together; however, PPC in cooperation with Fr. Chrys has been given the responsibility from Finance Committee to develop policies, guidelines, and procedures for pastoral initiatives aligned with St. Timothy's Vision and Mission as well as with Diocesan guidelines.

With this change, your PPC has been active and busy since September 2017 with the following activities:

- Organized the Alpha program and coordinated 17 volunteers who served about 40 participants for 10 weeks with delicious meals, inspiring videos about our God, and facilitated sharing of meaningful dialogues around table groups.
- Developed a Policy, Guidelines and Procedures document that outlines the role and responsibilities of the Parish Pastoral Council.
- Consulted with our various ministries and committees using a survey to learn more about their goals and how better to support and nourish their gifts as they meet the needs of our parish community.
- Collaborating with the Choir Directors to host a music workshop this fall, in recognition of the dedication and the importance of our Music Ministry.
- Planning and collaborating with other ministries for more faith and spiritual growth and development for our parish community this coming fall. Watch for announcements on further initiatives.
- Continuing to discern and plan how to transform St. Timothy to be a mission parish.

It was an opportunity to get closer to my Lord by strengthening my faith in Him and learn to work and collaborate with other members of the council in the fulfillment of the mission."*
- ⇒ *Through participation on the Council I "look at our parish and community with a deepened sense of service to our church family and profound appreciation for the 200+ parishioners that are volunteering their time and talents so that we all can deepen our faith."*
